


Area: about 58 thousand square meters. 18 artifacts present on the site for a total volume of about 81 thousand cubic meters

Ownership: State Property.



The proposed transformation pertains to a section of the former 'G. Perotti' military barracks area, a complex dating back to the early 1940s, located on the eastern outskirts of Bologna in close proximity to the ring road and motorway junction.

The area is located on the outskirts of a portion of the city, planned and built post World War II and is characterised by a robust network of green spaces, slow mobility routes and a strong presence of services for the population. To the south lies a district designated for Affordable and Popular Housing constructed in the 1970s.







In the immediate context, several initiatives are underway that will shape the future configuration of the area such as the construction of a complex designed for public functions and the offices of the Revenue Agency, in another section of the former 'Perotti' barracks.

The creation of new services and planned networking interventions make the area particularly attractive for green and inclusive urban regeneration, including services, public spaces and housing.
