Reinventing Cities MILANO EX SCUOLA DI VIA ZAMA





Area: Subject of the call are the two buildings of the former primary school and the gymnasium (20 thousand cubic meters in total volume) and the pertinent open space (about 3,700 square meters)

Ownership: Municipality of Milan



The proposed transformation concerns two buildings initially designed as a primary school and a gymnasium, along with an adjacent open area, located in the southeastern district of Milan.

The site is part of the residential, tertiary and productive urban context that characterizes the Forlanini district, interested by a numerous urban regeneration initiatives, either in the planning stages or underway.

To the west of the railway that runs along Via Zama is the Ex-Macello area, a site in competition from a previous Reinventing Cities edition and a future location of housing, services, social and work functions, as well as 'Mercato Ortofrutticolo' (Fruit and Vegetable Market), which is currently being redeveloped.

The property, owned by the Municipality of Milan, is characterized by the presence of dense trees grown over the years within the green courtyard and is accessible by public road equipped with underservices, urbanized and adequately infrastructured.
